RANGE REGULATIONS FOR STICKLEDOWN GALLERY RANGE

THE RANGE	
Name	Stickledown Gallery Range
Description	Stickledown long-range gallery consists of 50 lanes at 800-1100yds, 25 target lanes at 1200yds (21-33 and 39-50) and a Buffalo target (target 51). There is no firing facility forward of the 800yds firing point.
FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION	
Firearms and ammunition that may be fired on the range including ME & MV	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Rifles; and long range pistols by special arrangement only <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) A maximum muzzle velocity of 1000 m/s (3280 ft/s) (b) A maximum muzzle energy of 4500 J (3319 ft lb) (c) Firearms 4500J – 7000J HME procedures apply <p>Note – NRA members are not permitted to fire .338 rifles on Stickledown Range.</p> <p>Military personnel are permitted to fire .338 under MOD regulations on lanes 1 – 21.</p>
RANGE SAFETY LIMITATIONS	
Coordinating Instructions	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All movement forward of the 800yd point must be coordinated and controlled by the Range Office and is to be via the gate to the left of the 800yd firing point. 2. When the Ammunition Disposal range is in use the minimum shooting distance is 900yds. 3. 1200yd shooting is only permitted on targets 21 – 33 and 39 – 50 inclusive. 4. 1200yds shooting is not permitted: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - from the right hand side of the range unless the NRA has priority i.e. Cottesloe Heath is not in use. - if Butt Zero is in use 5. When firing is conducted at 1200yds: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cottesloe Heath Barrier CLOSED - Barrier to rear of FP CLOSED - Central Road Barrier @ 1100x CLOSED - Live Fire board in the appropriate position on the track to the rear of the 1100yd FP. - Shooting at 1100x is restricted to Targets 1 - 35

	<p>If on lanes 21 – 33</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Barrier LHS 1000yds CLOSED - Elcho Rd gate at corner CLOSED - William Evans Barrier CLOSED <p>6. 1100yd shooting is not permitted on Tgts 43 – 50 if Cottesloe Heath is in operation</p> <p>7. If Butt Zero is in use the following restrictions apply:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. If the left hand bay is use, then 900 yard shooting is permitted from target 8. b. If the centre bay is in use, then 900 yard shooting is permitted from target 13. c. If the 3rd (left hand) bay is in use for an NRA event, the 900 yard shooting is permitted from target 21 <p>8. If civil police are using Butt Zero, no shooting is permitted to the left of lane (below) 23</p> <p>9. The following activities are not permitted on Stickledown Range when the civil police are using Butt Zero.</p> <p>Guest Days Module 1 Probationary Training Any activity involving gallery rifles, shotguns or pistols Any activity involving automatic fire Any use of semi-automatic firearms other than by government personnel on duty Fire and movement Engagement of hard targets.</p>
Firing positions	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All firing is to be conducted from the left of pegs. 2. Firing is to be carried out from the prone or supine position, or from a bench except where expressly provided by the conditions of a particular discipline or approved competition rules. 3. Permission to fire from any other position must be granted by the Range Office and notified in the booking request in order to allow suitable target allocation on the range.
Targetry	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. Unless prior permission has been obtained from the CE only targets from the NRA approved set may be used. 5. Targets are to be used in the frames or holders provided and are to be engaged only from the recognised firing points 6. Laterally moving targets are not permitted on Gallery ranges
